Astrological Midpoints

History of Midpoint Combinations

What is a Midpoint?

The use of midpoints historically goes back to 1200 AD when Guido Bonati, a famous Italian Astrologer, used half sums, otherwise known as midpoints, in his interpretation of a chart. More recently at the turn of the century, Alan Leo, a famous American Astrologer, used midpoints along with solar arc directions. I personally have no knowledge of the use of midpoints combined with the 90-degree dial prior to its use by Reinhold Ebertin and Alfred Witte at the beginning of the Nineteen Hundreds. The history of solar arcs on the other hand, goes back to Ptolemy who used primary directions in the second century.

A midpoint is the center between any two points, which in Astrology relates to the center between two planets and/or personal points, including the Midheaven, Ascendant, and the Nodes. This center point is the meeting of planetary energies that becomes active through the process of growth, relating to the passage of time. We relate to the aspects formed by the heavenly bodies through spatial relationship. This system as I mentioned earlier goes back to Reinhold Ebertin who, near the turn of the century developed this system along with Alfred Witte by taking a 360-degree wheel and breaking it down into a 90-degree dial. Ebertin believed that hard aspects created events in one's life thus; the use of the 90-degree dial became a viable tool for forecasting future events. Ebertin started by placing the planets into three sections -- 30 degrees for Cardinal Positions which include: Aries, Cancer, Libra and Capricorn points; 30 degrees for Fixed Positions which include: Taurus, Leo, Scorpio and Aquarius points; and 30 degrees for Mutable Positions which include: Gemini, Virgo, Sagittarius and Pisces points.

This system can be seen on the 90 degree dial as 0 to 30 degrees as Cardinal, 30 to 60 degrees Fixed and 60 to 90 degrees as Mutable positions for the planetary points to be placed in accordance of their quality.

How to Use this System

This system can be used to add great insight into the interpretations of the natal chart through the use of delineation of transits, progressions, solar arcs and degree arcs. In fact it can be used in almost any interpretive form of astrology where timing is added into the equation. Timing is where this type of Astrology becomes very precise and accurate. The best way to use this system is to incorporate the natal midpoint along with the time that its energy becomes activated by directing the planets into the future. This is done by Solar Arc, which is the distance it takes for the Sun to move from one day to the next at the time of one's birth, which is approximately 59' to 1 degree 2', which is then added to the age in question. We can also use degree arcs, known as age arcs, which is equivalent to one degree equals one year, times the number of years old you are now and/or when the specific event in question occurred. It may sound difficult, but it's not once you become familiar with this system of delineation. When using this tool you will notice that I have included health interpretations along with dietary issues, which often come up when there is a lack of good nutrition or assimilation of nutrients. This can be seen easily through the activation of the natal midpoints on the 90-degree dial. Thus, I included medical interpretations in most of the midpoint structures.

Each midpoint structure has many meanings, so I have narrowed it down to the most important interpretation of each of them based upon my years of past experience. These interpretations are done in the higher and lower, or shadow manifestations. We are all on the earth plane of existence, thus no matter how enlightened we may seem, we still have to deal with our shadow. Many midpoints include births, health areas and transitions and only a part of what is said may apply to you personally. But on the other hand the whole interpretation may apply. I have included the positive and negative side of each of these midpoints so as to reach all probable outcomes.

Many times there will be others who are read through one's personal chart, since these people become the players in one's personal movie. These players include midpoints with:

Moon = Mother and the Feminine principal

Saturn = Father/Business Associates, masculine principal

Mercury/Mars = Brothers and Male Relatives Mercury/Venus = Sisters and Female Relatives

Sun/Node = Children

Venus/Uranus = Female Friends Mars/Uranus = Male Friends Jupiter = Grandparents

Relationships include almost any midpoint, which involves the Sun, Moon, Venus and Mars combined with the personal points, Asc, Mc, Moon and Node and always be aware of the rulerships of these positions.

Your Birth Chart: Midpoint Combinations

The natal midpoints represent our birth traits, our strengths, weaknesses and potential for personal growth. Each midpoint could involve others who are part of our life's path. Thus, a natal midpoint may apply to family and friends as opposed to the energy being directed to the self. Likewise, the medical influences and health issues mentioned are often manifest by others in our lives as opposed to the self. The possible medical problems, as well as the "shadow side" of a midpoint may never become an active manifestation of the midpoint's energy when addressed early. Keep an open mind when reading the interpretations of a midpoint since they are geared to both the higher and lower manifestations of the energy, and be aware that medical references should not be treated as a diagnosis. Psychological or physical symptoms or problems should be directed to the appropriate professional for diagnosis and evaluation. The timing of the events indicated by these natal midpoints are activated by progressions, directions and finally transits as the final touch off point sometime in the future.

Moon=Mercury/Mars Natal

These are usually very expressive people who have strong feelings and emotions to say exactly what they are thinking. It fact, their thoughts are influenced by their emotions. This can also come in the nature of nagging on someone or being overly critical and verbally abusive. This relates to the angry woman, who says exactly what she's thinking. Usually there's an imbalance here and the woman doesn't feel that she has been treated fairly, and/or there may be stored up anger from early childhood. Either way, anger is a way of expressing one's dominant nature over others. Possibly a good use of this energy would be to write out one's thoughts and put them in the freezer to let them cool down before saying it out loud.

Moon=Mercury/Uranus Natal

An emotional shock in early life, or an unstable home life resulting in many moves, is a manifestation of this energy. There can be disconnection from the family as well as having the ability to mentally control one's emotions, mainly because of being detached from one's feelings. There can also be many projects and a sense of confusion surrounding loss of paper work. One may feel that there are many changes in friendships that affect their sense of stability. One may have to relate to unstable females in their life who are changeable, moody, and/or confused. The positive use of this energy would be to get away by oneself for a while and leave the family issues behind.

Moon=Venus/Mars Natal

Becoming a mother for the first time and/or to be emotionally connected to one's mate is a manifestation of this energy as well as having the desire to marry early in life due to an unplanned pregnancy. There can also be success as an interior decorator along with the love of a home that may be filled with activity and social occasions.

Moon=Venus/Uranus Natal

The birth of a very intelligent or gifted child where a great love bond is formed with the extended family is a manifestation of this energy, or there can be emotional excitement

experienced with others. There can be difficulty with a volatile woman in a love relationship now, or, on the positive side, there can also be many new friendships developed amongst women. One has the capacity to make unique changes in the décor of the home. On the financial level, there can be sudden gain made through the help of friends, along with many social occasions that bring happiness through the associations with others.

Moon=Jupiter (Great Feelings) Natal

The Moon/Jupiter gives expansion of the environment, a large family and/or the woman with a great philosophy on life or the family's belief system. It represents one's physical presence or moving to a larger home and/or to the love of family and home life. It's when one moves up in the world and finds happiness and abundance in one's life's path; thus it's the good life. There's the capacity to be emotionally receptive to the needs of others. It relates to having a highly religious and/or philosophical nature. There can also be a grandmother with a strong heritage and belief system who's at the head of the family. Usually there's a happy family and success and opportunities with real estate. An image of this could be the happy woman who loves to travel, especially to see the family ancestral home, since this represents the history or heritage of the family, thus genealogy. Many times it gives the desire to become a priest and/or a nun or becoming involved with someone of a religious nature. The luck of the Irish is with this energy and there is also the love of sports that the whole family becomes involved in. On a medical level, this tends to increase one's weight due to the love of food, which also relates to the large-breasted woman. One the shadow side, this relates to inherited diseases.

Sun=Jupiter/Saturn Natal

Gaining in life through experiencing many ups and downs is an influence of this energy, giving a sense of the correct direction to finally take. In early life, one may have skipped vital phases in one's growth -- like trying to get rich quick, by not paying the piper. Thus, through the process of a shortcut, one learns a lot about when to expand and contract, when to buy and when to sell. Many times one is trying to overcome something, possibly in a health area where wrong belief and/or the diet, has effected the liver.

Mercury=Sun/Midheaven Natal

This relates to the writer who gains fame and notoriety, or a person who becomes successful due to their excellent sales skills and ability to communicate effectively. There could be effective negotiating skills and it gives the capacity to express one's self easily through public speaking gifts, and often one can speak more than one language. There can also be a sibling or relative who takes precedence under this and become successful in his or her own right. On the whole, this is the bearer of good news coming, thus advancing one on a professional level through agreements or contracts.

Mercury=Venus (Pleasant Communications) Natal

When Mercury and Venus combine they create beauty through communication as well as being the bearer of good news. There can be a pleasant speaking voice and/or a beautiful singing voice. In the career area, this energy can be applied to writing articles about beauty, love, a book on love, or love poems. The capacity to make one's living as a sales person or through sales, or to be a financial negotiator is another manifestation of this energy. This relates to the diplomat, where there is a mutual exchange of ideas in a harmonious way. Contractual agreements also come under this and usually end up favorable, thus, many attorneys and arbitrators carry this energy. There is a tendency to speak beautifully and to create beauty with one's hands -- as in crafts and drawings -- and/or having beautiful hands. On the relationship side, there can be hearing from a loved

one, talk of an engagement, communication about one's feeling of love for another, and/or an agreement to marriage. One may also have artistic abilities. There may be a Libran sister or a beautiful aunt; there is a lot of talking about one's personal appearance. It gives pleasant communications amongst relatives and visits with them, and there is also the possibility of the birth of a sister and/or extended contact with a sibling.

Mercury=Pluto/Ascendant Natal

Powerful communicative abilities along with the capacity to dominate others thoughts and/or words are manifestations of this. Thus, this relates to manipulative people who knows something about someone and holds it over them. This energy can be used as a healing tool for others through one's ability to get to the truth of the matter along with the capacity to see beyond all of one's projections. This also relates to contact with a sibling or the birth of a sibling.

Venus=Sun/Midheaven Natal

An attraction to and/or from the opposite sex that can lead to engagement is the main function of this. It can bring a mate or even a soul mate into one's life now, or someone with whom one may want to work and/or spend the rest of their life. It represents happiness and success coming in through the relationships we attract to us. It gives a beautiful voice or artistic ability that leads to success in the arts. Usually this represents the beautiful person who attracts financial success through their career and who has a popular personality.

Venus=Pluto/Ascendant Natal

One can meet someone now with whom they have an intense attraction to and fall deeply in love. Thus, one may even want to partner them in the future. This also relates to the potential to improve one's exterior appearance, making one more sensually attractive; thus this rules plastic surgery, which has the capacity to give one the desired look they want. There's also the ability to manifest things easily in one's life, due to one's personality, which is well liked and personable. One can also create financial security due to wise investments.

Mars=Jupiter/Node Natal

This brings a mate into one's life who has a strong, physical Martian nature. It connects one to groups whose emphasis is on the physical body, as in a health club or any group whose focus is health and healing. This is a very procreative time, indicating the birth of a male child. In the work area, this energy connects one with co-workers, representing teamwork especially if it's a physical labor job.

Jupiter=Moon (Great Feelings) Natal

The Moon/Jupiter gives expansion of the environment, a large family and/or the woman with a great philosophy on life or the family's belief system. It represents one's physical presence or moving to a larger home and/or to the love of family and home life. It's when one moves up in the world and finds happiness and abundance in one's life's path; thus it's the good life. There's the capacity to be emotionally receptive to the needs of others. Jupiter=Mercury/Mars Natal

This relates to people who usually have a good sense of judgment and/or are involved in the decision making process, such as judges who have a sense of justice and balance when it comes to making decisions for others. This is basically a happy energy that makes one feel that they're in the right and have a good, sound belief system. This also relates to coming into a large sum of money due to sales agreements as well as judgments that go in one's favor.

Jupiter=Mercury/Uranus Natal

This relates to optimistic people who are fortunate in life as well as having a sibling with the capacity to have a high IQ and excel in academia. One could become a great astrologer, due to the ability to comprehend and synthesize many variables at once. This relates to higher education, university, and specialized schools, thus one has the capacity to be a philosopher and/or teacher of technical subjects. There can also be hearing good news or hearing of good fortune for another. This is also a great time to speculate and win.

Jupiter=Venus/Mars Natal

People with this can have a strong sensual philosophy or belief system about relationships, as well as a happy sexual relationship. There can be many fun times with people from other cultures or nationalities. Lots of sexual activity is one of the manifestations of this, as well being a person who is lucky in love. There is an ease in getting what one wants, especially when it comes to love and money.

Jupiter=Venus/Uranus Natal

There can be many friends of a higher mind or philosophy such as astrologers or people involved in academia. One has the capacity to be well-liked and admired for what one knows, and there can be the sudden winning of a prize or money coming to them unexpectedly. The successful artist or associating with artists and having a strong appreciation of their talents is a representation of this. One could also fall in love with a successful person, however fleeting it may be.

Saturn=Mars/Ascendant Natal

One can hold themselves back from their full potential due to early inhibitions. Thus, if one works with their early environmental conditioning they could overcome some of the obstacles that seem to hold them back or keep them in the same place without advancement. People who have this seem to have physical strength and a sense of purpose. One usually has the intention to somehow get the job done no matter what the obstacles are. There can also be sadness which is shared with others due to a loss or concern for others.

Uranus=Sun/Neptune Natal

On its highest level, this represents new age thought and the star children who have come to inspire us beyond our present reality. This relates to spiritual friends and associations with people who have a similar belief system or faith. It rules churches and synagogues which house belief systems. There can be a sacred journey made with others to have a vision quest. Substance abuse issues are common among friends and associates when this is activated.

Uranus=Jupiter/Node Natal

This connects people who are highly evolved mentally, like the MENSA group, or even an astrological group. It represents someone who is coming into one's life who has qualities which could stimulate one mentally to learn and be inspired through knowledge. This also relates to institutions of higher learning, as in going on to college and/or to university.

Uranus=Saturn/Pluto Natal

Big changes can happen in one's life due to a need for a new career or the need for a major shift of one's financial circumstances. On the negative side, there can be sudden acts of violence that come out of the blue. This also relates to someone who has no natural fear; thus, it's present with stunt people in the movie industry, racecar drivers, and basically people who take chances with their life force.

Neptune=Mercury/Midheaven Natal

There is a tendency to have unclear motivations when it comes to career direction, or one could have the ability to communicate through music or poetry. Thus, there's the capacity to write lyrics and to play a musical instrument with ease. There can also be dissolutions with others due to misunderstandings or deceptions regarding one's intent; but on the positive side, one could be a gifted psychic or writer of spiritual matters. This also denotes a sibling or relative that seems to be out of touch with reality, living in his or her own little world. But there is also the capacity to be a visionary, work in television, or work as an actor.

Neptune=Ascendant (The Spiritual Environment) Natal

Neptune to the Ascendant can give one the desire to create a more spiritual environment and/or place where one can relax and feel alone. Many times there is a feeling of being alone by one's self even if the room is filled with people. There's a tendency to live more in the dream world, not in reality. Thus it becomes difficult to know if it's real or not. There could also be addictive behavior.
